Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Tanker/Vehicle Accident Call the emergency services: Dial 111 Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, full length clothing and PVC gloves. Sweep up spilled product and place in a Spill or leak sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal. Fire Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with water. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away. **FIRST AID** If Swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately If in Eves Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If on Skin If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin. If Inhaled Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop. STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use. Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered.
